

Privacy Statement

HHS-TV is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the HHS-TV Web site and governs data collection and usage. By using the HHS-TV website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by HHS-TV. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by HHS-TV for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the HHS-TV Web site.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through HHS-TV public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others. Note: HHS-TV does not read any of your private online communications.

HHS-TV encourages you to review the privacy statements of Web sites you choose to link to from HHS-TV so that you can understand how those Web sites collect, use and share your information. HHS-TV is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites outside of the HHS-TV and HHS-TV family of Web sites.

Use of your Personal Information

HHS-TV keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within HHS-TV, in order to determine what HHS-TV services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within HHS-TV to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

HHS-TV Web sites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on HHS-TV or the site; (b) protect and defend the

rights or property of HHS-TV; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of HHS-TV, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The HHS-TV Web site use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize HHS-TV pages, or register with HHS-TV site or services, a cookie helps HHS-TV to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same HHS-TV Web site, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the HHS-TV features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the HHS-TV services or Web sites you visit.
